




Number of people with disability

- **9 939 unemployed people with disability (7,6% of the total number of unemployed) in Dec, 2011**



Disability aspects in EU funds



People with disability in the EU co-financed projects (2011)

- **10,159 persons with disability participated in EU co-financed projects (5418 women and 4741 men) or 4.6% of the total ESF and ERDF participants, including:**
- **- 1993 persons with visual disability (1088 women and 905 men)
- 389 persons with hearing disability (181 women and 208 men)
- 855 persons with physical disability(415 women and 440 men)
- 1040 persons with mental disability (443 women and 597 men)
- 5917 persons with other disabilities.**
- **People with disability were most represented in the 25-54 age group - 4705 (including 2567 women and 2138 men)**



How MOW supported the implementers for EU Funds? (I)

- Manual** “How to ensure equal opportunities in projects co-financed by the EU Funds”, which is a methodological material for the project applicants, evaluators and employees of institutions involved in management of EU Funds (by 12/2008)
- Guidelines** for environmental accessibility, which is a auxiliary material for the architects, builders, municipal employees, ERDF project implementers etc.(by 11/2011)
- Training film** on best practice examples on environmental accessibility in the projects co-financed by ERDF or CF (by 11/2011)

- Seminars** for the project applicants, evaluators and employees of institutions involved in the management of EU Funds, employees of regional information centre of EU Funds

- Working group** of environmental accessibility to assess the environmental requirements for accessibility for people with disabilities as well as to improve the control and monitoring mechanisms for construction sector




How MOW supported the implementers for EU Funds? (III)

Environmental accessibility in the ERDF and CF co-financed projects
